## 1/ Workshop address:

The workshop will take lace at the *European Doctoral College*: *48 boulevard de la Victoire in Strasbourg*. (GPS Coord.: 48.58169970751068, 7.768373939261272)

If you join by car, there are paid parking places at « rue de l'Université », above less than 5 min by feet.

# 2/ Access:

If you travel by train: you could raise the workshop place by tram from Strasbourg train station. (You could by bus tickets on the bus ticket vending machine or by the « CTS Strasbourg » App.)

Take tram C from the station, towards Neuhof R. Reuss. Get off at the Observatoire stop.

Journey time: 15 to 20 minutes

The European Doctoral College is close to the tram station.



If you travel by plane, there is some direct train line between the airport and the station. (There is a train station at the airport.)
